Thank you to all who, yet again, emailed HBC to register your concern at the continuing unsatisfactory situation.

In brief:

- HBC continues to work on developing its next scheme for Newberries.
- HBC does so 'behind closed doors', without input from or communication with TRACKS (you).
- Since May HBC has rejected all requests that it *now* meet with TRACKS (you).
- Cllr. Bright has informed a resident he believes TRACKS may have a political agenda, also hopes of political office. **For the record**, TRACKS has never had either – also, no evidence to the contrary has ever existed.
- Cllr. Morris has informed a resident he was unable to confirm TRACKS was GDPR compliant. **For the record**, TRACKS notified Cllr. Morris that it was GDPR compliant seven days *prior* to him so informing the resident.

N.B. The residents' emails (to which above replies were made) contained no reference to "politics" or "GDPR".

TRACKS has secured a meeting with APC and continues trying to secure one with HBC – your MP's assistance to achieve this has been sought.
