Following its meeting with you last month the committee has discussed and reviewed TRACKS' position in light of all now known facts.

It was decided:

- TRACKS will communicate/collaborate with its members and HBC to acquire and disseminate maximum knowledge of both parties' views, wishes, plans, etc.
- TRACKS will inform its members they should, at their discretion and in capacity of resident, propose directly to HBC any scheme they favour.
- TRACKS can/should not develop, propose or promote a 'TRACKS' scheme.
- TRACKS can/should not endorse or support any scheme.
- Any ballot to select between development schemes should include option to respond (i) none approved (ii) no development of such scale wanted.

These decisions reflect that the function of TRACKS is to ascertain, represent and promote the views and wishes of its members – if you would like more explanation of any decision please ask me for this.

TRACKS has no pre-conceived view about any scheme, also no wish other than to co-operate with HBC in every way possible.
